

Mandatory Rules and Regulations for Bus Travel

Required:

These items will be checked before you load the Bus.

- U.S. Government Issued Passport or Passport ID Card.
- Keep your Passport on you. Do not pack your Passport in a bag that will be stowed in the baggage compartment of the bus. You need your Passport, when crossing the border.
- SCUBA Certification Card
- Have luggage tags on all your bags.
- If you are under 18 years old, you will need a parent or guardian to accompany you to Mexico.

Packing:

- One medium size personal bag (4 day trip).
- One dive bag.
- Soft bags recommended (easier to pack on bus).
- Dive mesh bag (for boat excursions).
- Have luggage tags on all your bags.

Parking:

- Please plan on being dropped off at El Mar Diving Center Mesa, there is no overnight parking available.
- Please arrive by 6:30am to depart by 7:00am.
- Plan on returning to Mesa, between 5:00pm and 6:00pm.

Tips:

- Tipping of the bus driver and the boat crew is NOT included in the package price, and though not mandatory, is greatly appreciated. Recommended \$5 - 10/a day for boat and \$10/weekend for bus driver.

Divers:

- Be sure to make your reservation for rental gear when you sign up.
- Plan to pick up your rental equipment Tuesday or Wednesday, before the trip. You will not be able to pick up any equipment the day of departure.
- Certified divers MUST bring Certification Cards or they will not dive.
- Divers must have a Safety Tube and Whistle.
